If a dental referral is made directly through Crossroads, these guidelines apply:

1. Patient should be a resident of Bristol, Washington County VA or Sullivan County TN
2. Patient must be able to physically lean back in a dental chair for approximately 1 hour for dental procedures.
3. If patient has high blood pressure blood pressure needs to be addressed.
4. Patient must not require Oxygen Therapy
5. Patient must understand no pain medication stronger than Ibuprofen will be provided by dentist or CMM
6. Patient must understand the dentist will only extract and fill damaged teeth. The number of teeth done is up to the dentist's discretion. They may not pull all the teeth patient wants in one teeth
7. Sedation will not be provided. Anesthesia cannot be provided
